 - 1) The title summary of the resolution is as follows: A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF THE BROWARD SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT (BOARD) ENCOURAGING THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION ("PSC") TO SET MEANINGFUL ENERGY EFFICIENCY GOALS, TO MEET THOSE GOALS THROUGH PROGRAMS TARGETTED TO RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS WITH A FOCUS ON LOW TO MODERATE INCOME HOUSEHOLDS; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITAL OF THE RESOLUTION TO THE CHAIR AND CLERK OF THE PSC AND FILING IN RELEVANT PSC DOCKETS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
